

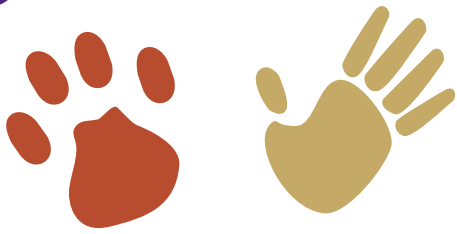

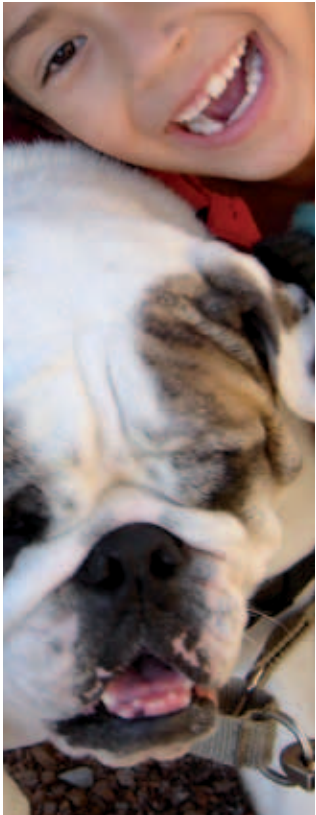

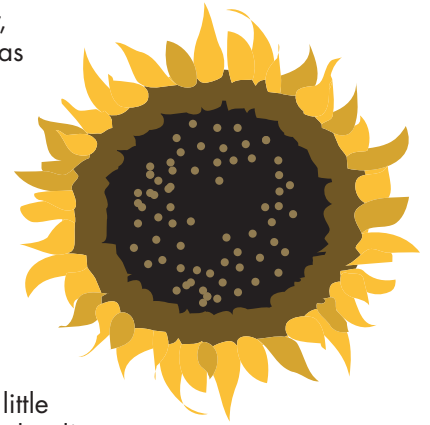
Pam and Gabriel

I'd like you to picture a sunflower in your head for me-but instead of bright and blossoming, that sunflower is rather downtrodden, maybe even withered and misshapen. Were you to take this sunflower home to try to nurse it back to health, your first instinct would probably be to get it into some fresh soil and provide it with plenty of water. In doing so, you would be meeting the immediate needs of that flower and giving it the best shot at survival. But to guarantee that it continues to recover, you would surely need to return day after

day, to make sure it not only has soil and water but to nurture it with care and attention, ensuring it has proper sunlight, for example, and trimmed leaves.

Many of the children that are served by the agencies that Gabriel's Angels Pet Therapy Teams visit are not unlike that bruised and battered sunflower.

Indeed, when Johnny arrived at the shelter he was dirty, hungry and in need of some minor medical care. He was four years old and removed from his home and placed in a safe haven in central Phoenix. Gabriel and I were visiting that day and the other children were brushing his coat and gently patting his head. As the children continued to interact with Gabriel, I watched as Johnny was first checked for bruises and scratches, turning my head as my heart ached for him. The nursery continued to attend to Johnny's basic needs, providing him with a bath and a meal. Still, Johnny looked both sad and frightened. Gabriel gently walked over and simply stood by Johnny as if to say, "It's okay little guy. You are safe here." Johnny then began to stroke Gabriel's soft fur and then buried his head in his neck. Johnny found comfort in Gabriel's unconditional love that day. After several other visits Johnny anticipated Gabriel coming and would say, "Fridays are my best day because Gabriel comes to see me." I knew I was watching another loving relationship between a child and Gabriel blossom that day, and that as a result Johnny's emotional needs were starting to be met.



At Gabriel's Angels we build on this trusting bond which enables us to teach empathy, compassion and trust to children who are victims of abuse and neglect. Once the basic needs of these children are met we must then address their emotional needs. Being clothed and fed is undoubtedly life-saving for a child. This fundamental care prepares them to begin the healing process-a process in which Pet Therapy is integral. Just as the sunflower blossoms when it receives both water and nurturance, it is when a child's basic and emotional needs are met that the opportunity to heal and to grow presents itself.

This past year has been both rewarding and challenging for Gabriel's Angels. While we have placed many new therapy teams, it has been difficult to keep up with the demand. In these economic times family stress is heightened and more children are adversely affected. We have seen a shift to basic needs being funded disproportionately as compared to emotional needs. Individuals have stepped up to fill this void and for that we are forever grateful.

We are very excited about our new office move which will enable us to recruit, train and place more Pet Therapy Teams to serve Arizona children. In the past at many of our Information Sessions our prospective volunteers experienced standing room only to hear how to become a Therapy Team or Helping Hand. Our new office is just perfect for us to conduct our day-to-day business, as well as hold our monthly board meetings, information sessions and training for volunteers. Many thanks to John and Susan Echeverri for their generous offer to house Gabriel's Angels and to Sarah Eagleburger for introducing them to Gabriel's Angels! Here is to an amazingly successful 2010!

## The Link



### The “Link” Between Domestic Violence and Animal Abuse

The term “Link” as coined by the American Humane Society, defines the substantiated correlation between child abuse, animal cruelty and other crimes of violence against humans. It is undeniable that animal abuse is often one of the early signs of families in crisis and is highly predictive in identifying children at risk for abuse and becoming potential abusers. This type of violence is insidious, cyclical and is passed on from one generation to the next without some form of intervention.

Current research shows that children who are abused are more likely to become abusive adults, and the strongest predictors of subsequent violence and abuse can be changed. Gabriel’s Angels directly addresses the root cause of this social problem by intervening in this perpetuating cycle, and treating the cause of the problem as well as the symptoms. Our Pet Therapy Program intervenes in the cycle of violence before these children grow into adulthood. We work on improving healthy core behaviors that are crucial to normal childhood development. Our Pet Therapy Program works on increasing empathy, self-esteem, trust, compassion, respect, and encouraging nurturing behavior in a safe environment.

As we learn more about how effective our programs are through our annual performance evaluations, we are continually creating enhancements that will make our visits even more helpful to the children and facilities we serve. Our Animals and Children Together (ACT) Learning Project is designed to provide targeted activities to three distinct age groups to develop core behaviors and intervene in the cycle of violence.



# Our History

**Gabriel's Angels** is, in part, named after our first registered therapy dog, Gabriel, a Weimaraner who is an advocate for abused children.

Our results with these first children were outstanding and exceeded even our own expectations! Both the on-site caregivers and social workers quickly confirmed that the children we worked with were more empathetic and nurturing to one another. We could see the improvement ourselves in the way they began treating Gabriel.

We knew that we could make a difference, and we began a concerted effort to tell as many people as possible about our program. In response to the overwhelming support and encouragement we received, **Gabriel's Angels** was incorporated as a nonprofit organization in the State of Arizona on May 12, 2000. On January 24, 2001, we were granted our 501(c)(3) status by the Internal Revenue Service retroactive to date of incorporation.



**Gabriel's Angels** has now grown to over 100 volunteer Pet Therapy Teams regularly visiting crisis nurseries, domestic violence shelters, group homes and residential treatment centers in the Phoenix and Tucson metropolitan areas. Each dog must undergo an evaluation process; each human volunteer must also be trained and pass the standard security screening required by state law.

The local media has generously recognized us for our Pet Therapy Program with abused, neglected and at-risk children. All local television stations have done stories on Gabriel's Angels, and our organization and its volunteers have been featured in the local and national print media as well, including the Arizona Republic, East Valley Tribune, Arizona Foothills Magazine, Money and a PBS Special Road Trip Nation.

## Highlights of Our Performance Evaluation - 2008

Our 2008 program evaluation results indicate that Gabriel's Angels Pet Therapy Program is making a significant difference in the lives of abused, neglected and at-risk children in the core behaviors needed to break the cycle of violence.

### Children We Served:

We provided services to approximately 12,000 children in the state of AZ. The average number of children served by Gabriel's Angels volunteers at partner facilities in 2008 is 144, with 23 facilities reporting.

The ethnic backgrounds of these children are also varied:

- Hispanic (35.5%)
- Caucasian (31.7%)
- African American (21.6%)
- Native American (7.8%)
- Other/Biracial/Multiracial (2.7%)
- Asian (0.4%)

### Changes in Core Competency Behaviors:

The goal of the Pet Therapy program is to affect behavioral change in abused, neglected and at-risk children.

Volunteers work to foster seven behaviors in particular that have been identified by renowned child development expert Dr. Bruce Perry as critical to the development of abused children (LeCroy & Milligan, 2006). These seven "core competencies" include:

- (1) trust and attachment;
- (2) affiliation;
- (3) confidence;
- (4) respect;
- (5) self-regulation;
- (6) awareness and
- (7) tolerance.

## The Impact of Our Programs

### Trust and Attachment

- Children make positive attachments and learn to love and trust again.
- Children who were "afraid" of dogs over time warmed up. Also, children with socialization issues showed a huge improvement in their ability to be part of a group.

### Affiliation

- Children who are less sure of themselves and reluctant to participate in other group activities are more comfortable in Gabriel's Angels group. Children who don't usually affiliate due to differences find common ground with the dogs.
- The Therapy Team volunteer teaches them the importance of being in a group, working together for a common goal.

### Confidence

- When the children walk the dog, you can see their demeanor change from the beginning of the walk to the end of it. It is a great confidence booster .
- After a few regular visits some of the children are confident enough to tell the new children in the classroom how to take care of the dog.

### Respect

- Building self-esteem is difficult for abused children, so any positive experience helps. For the children whose self-esteem is poor or unstable, success with the dogs lays building blocks.
- They are able to work on taking turns with the Therapy Dog and respecting boundaries and the children no longer take items from their peers or volunteers without asking.

### Self-Regulation

- Our children have many mental health issues due to abuse, causing episodes of acting out. These are lessened when the teams are present. Children follow guidelines that are set and remember them.
- During time with the Therapy Dog the children maintain control of (their) tempers, (and) are able to express wants/needs without shouting, kicking, etc.

### Awareness

- The children take turns brushing the dog and getting water. They share in the responsibility and know it is a community job.
- Pet therapy helps the children with empathy. They learn to associate their strengths and they encourage others to do their best.

### Tolerance

- The children discuss what the dog likes and dislikes and how the dog, like them, has feelings.
- The children became more accepting of themselves as well as with their peers.

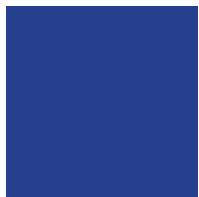
